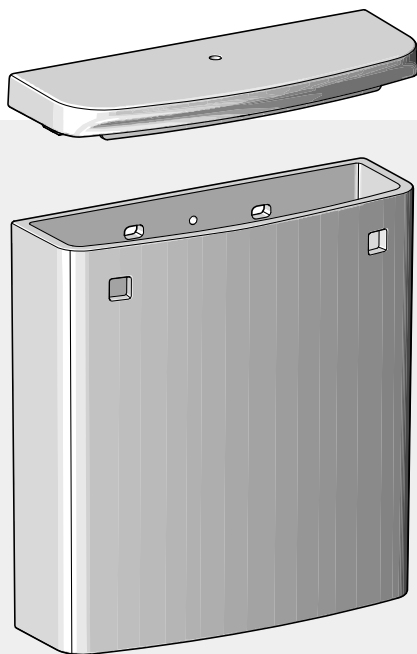

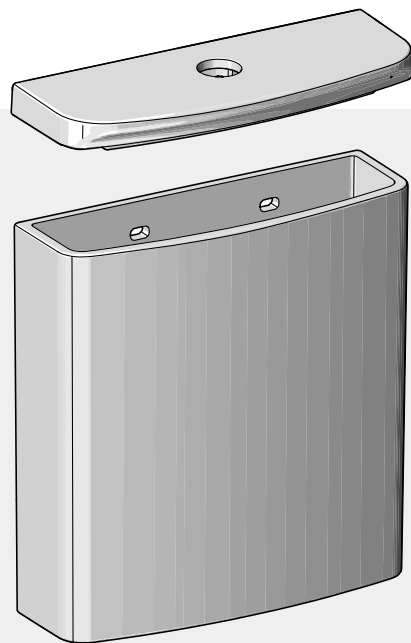

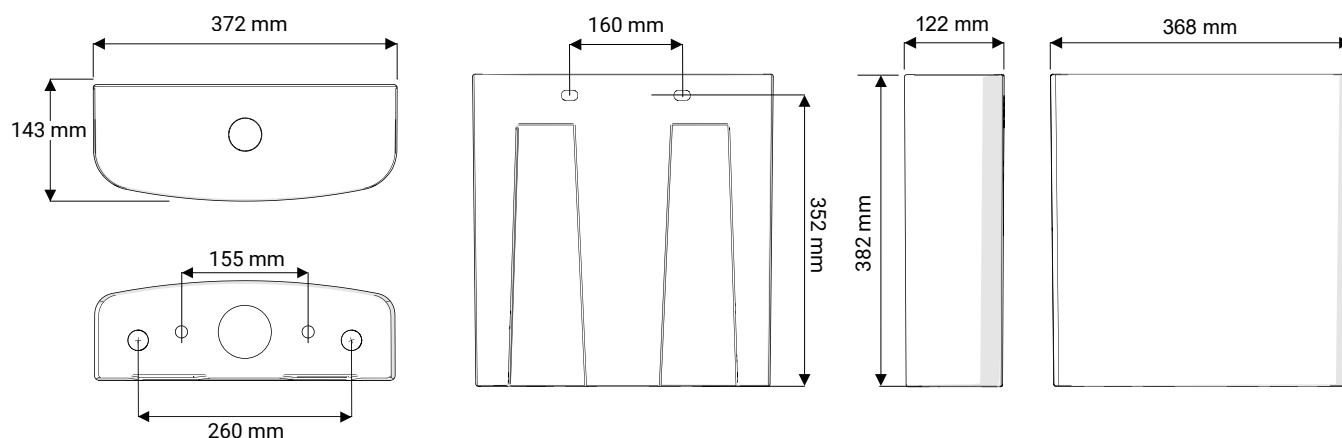
Cistern Push Button Flush

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Dimensions



Installation must be carried out in accordance with these instructions, and must be conducted by a qualified and competent installer.

This product must be installed in compliance with Water Regulations. Cold water isolating valves should be fitted to the inlet pipework.

Important: Access must be made available to the water supplies and fixings for future maintenance and servicing. Make sure all fixing holes are used and do not over-tighten the fixings.

Before you start

Remove all protective covering and examine carefully. Check that all items are present before discarding packaging. Notify the retailer immediately of any damage or faults. The manufacturer cannot be held responsible for any installation costs that may arise from damaged or faulty products being installed and not in accordance with these instructions. Dispose of all packaging in accordance with the local recycling authorities.

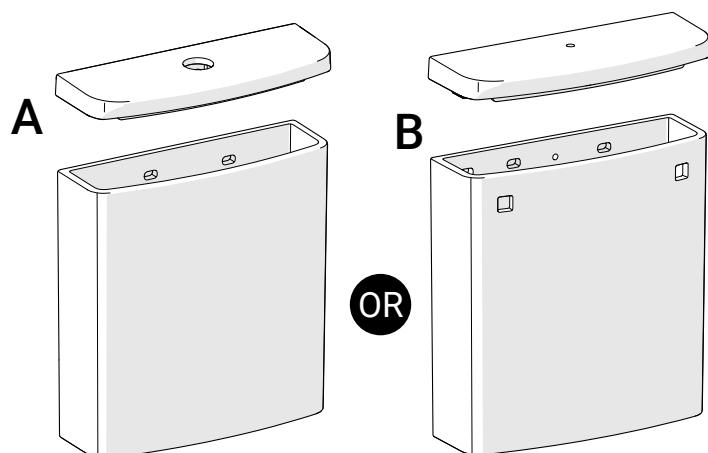
Safety

- Keep small parts and packaging away from children.



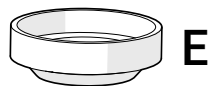
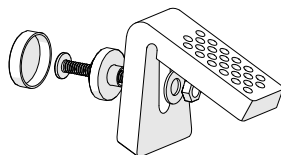
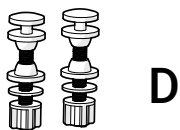
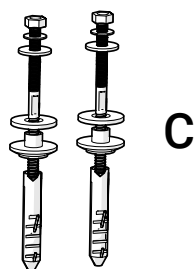

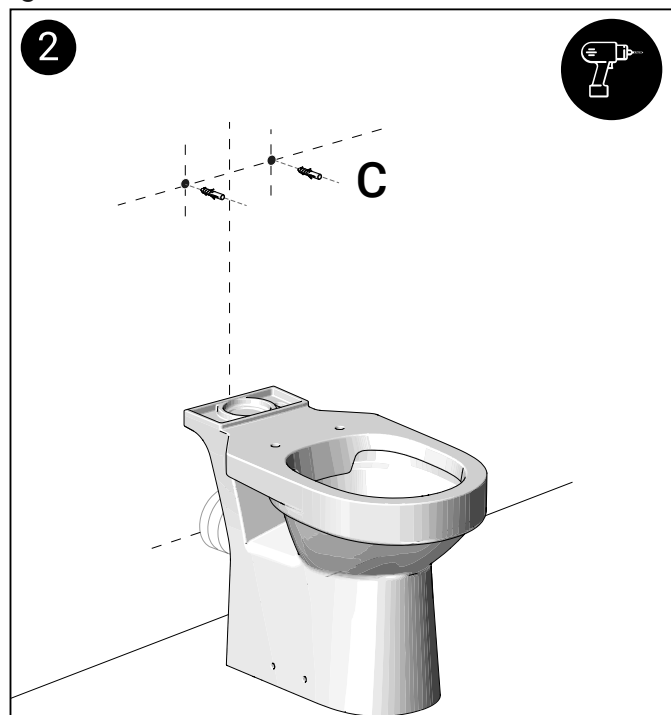
Note: follow the separate Navlin Doc M Toilet Pans installation instructions to determine if the Cistern needs to be connected to the Pan before installation.



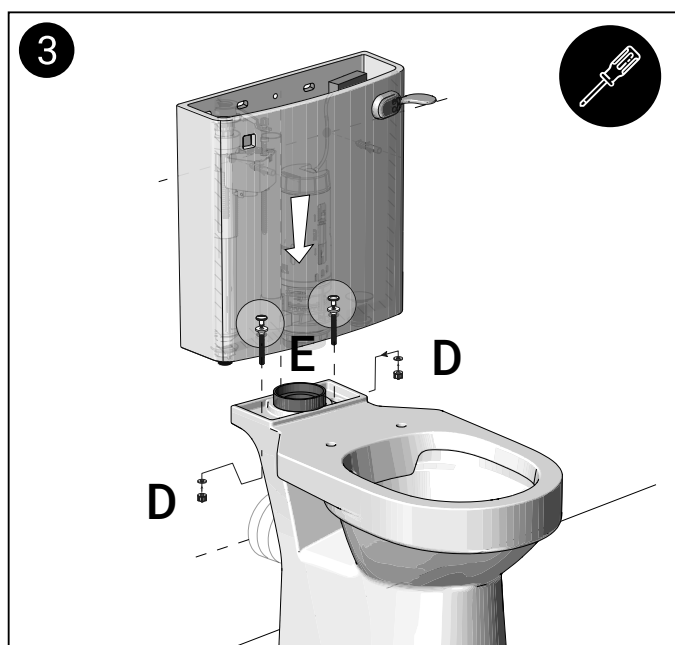
Important! Before installation, isolate the water supply. Ensure the area is smooth, level surface and clear of any loose building materials or sharp objects that could damage the ceramic during installation. Carefully measure and install all necessary pipework prior to installing the toilet.



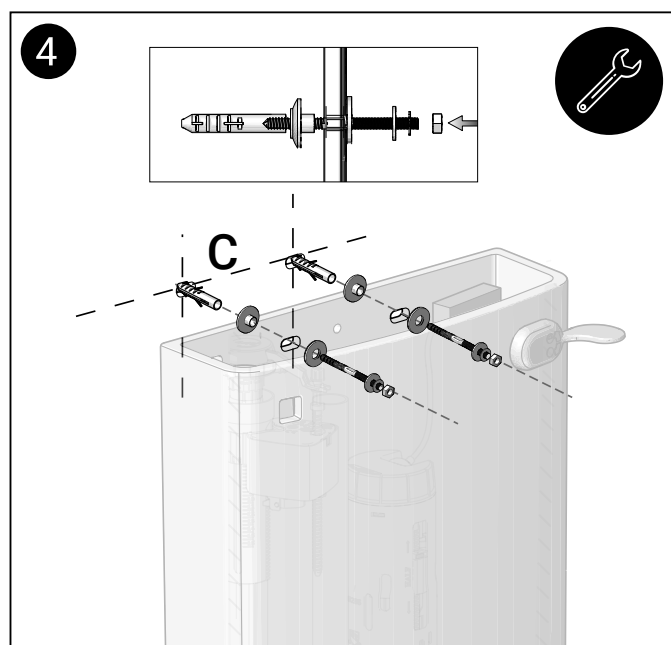
Carefully align the toilet cistern into position against the wall. Ensure that the cistern is level and mark the mounting holes through the back of the cistern.



Remove the cistern and check levels are true. Drill the marked holes and insert the wall plugs. If you are drilling into tiles use a special tile drill kit.



Ensure that the cistern gasket (E) is between the cistern and pan. Carefully fit the cistern onto the toilet pan using the supplied connecting bolts and washers (D). The rubber washers must go on the inside of the cistern with the nuts on the outside.

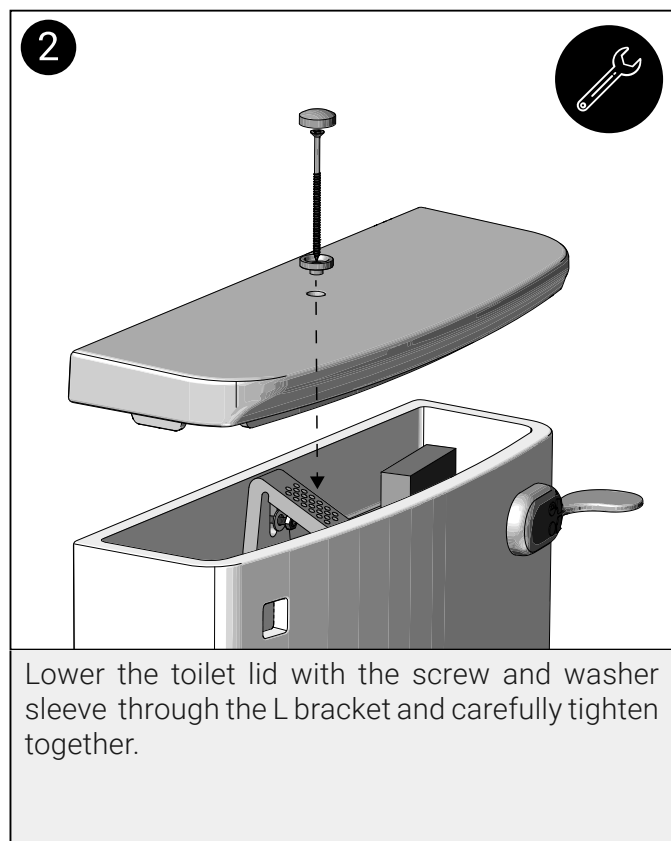
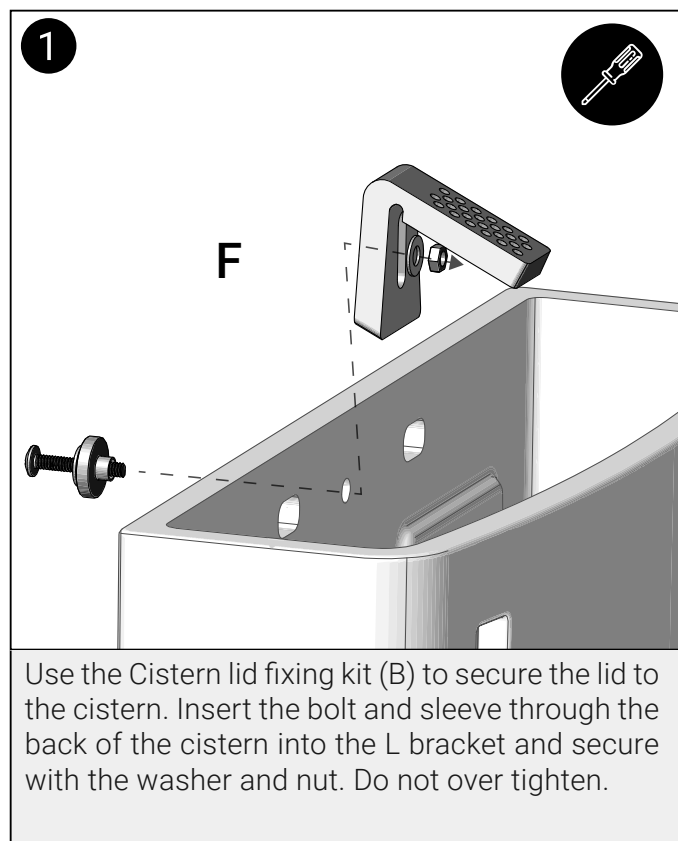


Realign the cistern with the drilled holes. Insert wall fixing bolts and carefully tighten with a spanner. Use the plastic wall spacers and washers so the porcelain is not directly against the wall. Secure the cistern with the washers and nuts.

Lid Installation

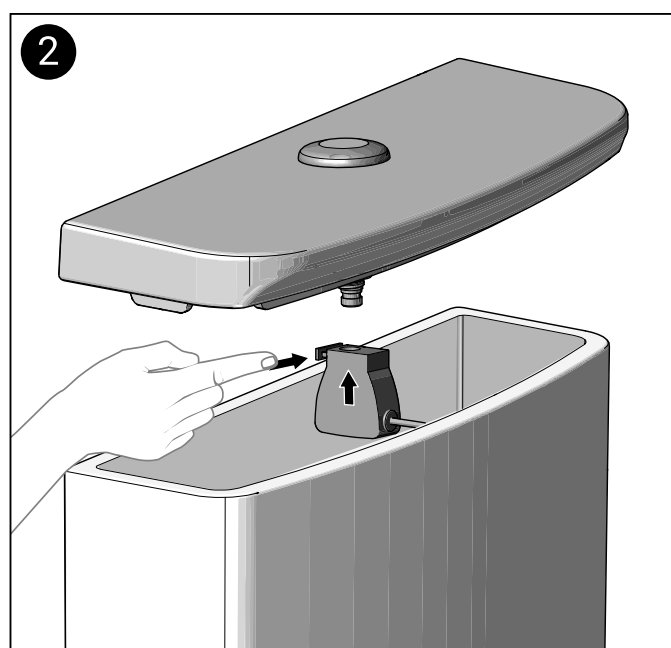
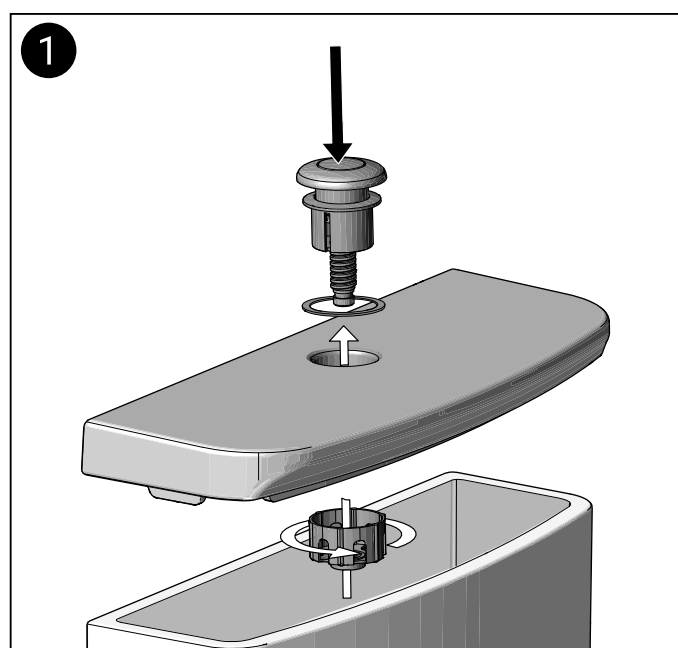
Cistern Lid Securing Kit for cisterns with a lever flush.

Warranty applies only to manufacturing or material defects, conditional on the one-time correct installation of the product. It does not apply to:

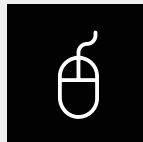
- Inappropriate use or accidental damage.
