Guarantee

All our cultured marble products carry a five year guarantee against faulty manufacture, calculated from the purchase date. Conditions for validity of the guarantee are normal use, as well as installation by a qualified professional. Later alterations of any kind, especially to the surface, as well as air bubbles on the underside of products delivered by us are excluded from this guarantee.

Certificate of quality

The products have been manufactured for more than 35 years according to extremely strict environmental standards, and are completely in harmony with Man and Nature. The products consist of mineral powder/polyester resin. The surface is protected by gelcoat, which is at least 0.5 mm thick.

Resistance

Quality criteria for our products comply with norms:

1. CE/EN - issued by the European Committee (CEN European Committee for standardization) - marked with "CE" symbol

Norm EN 14688 - (for wash basins)

Norm EN 14527 - (for shower trays)

Norm EN 14516 - (for bathtubs)

Directions for care

How to care for a cultured marble product:

- Clean with normal liquid detergent. Marmite Clean & Shine can be used for good effect. N.B. Do not use detergent containing abrasives.
- Buff with a good quality polish, then wax (car care products are a good alternative). If these instructions are followed regularly, the product will keep its fine appearance for many years to come.
- Do not expose the product to acids, ammonia, drain cleaner, hair dyes or chlorine. If, for some reason, the surface should become scratched or faded, polish and wax according to the above instructions. Deeper scratches can first be carefully polished with wet strength sandpaper (approx. 1200 grain). If more serious damage occurs, your retailer can supply you with a repair kit.
