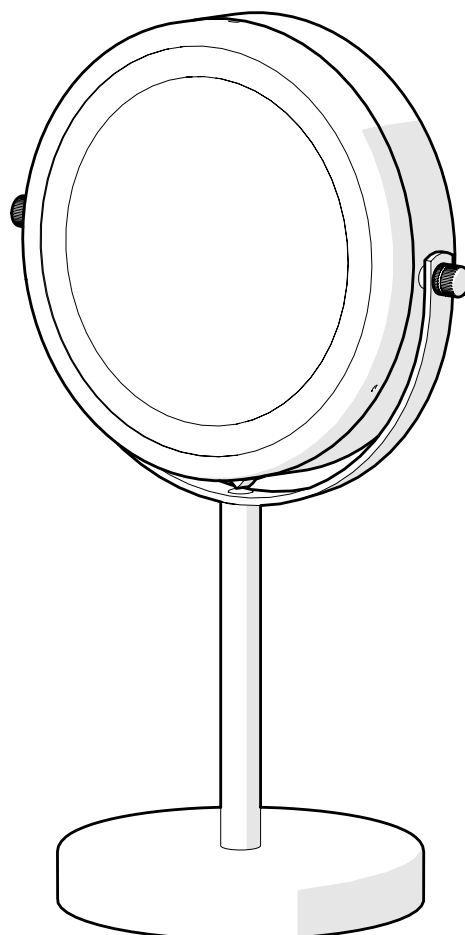

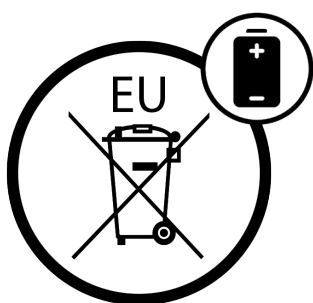

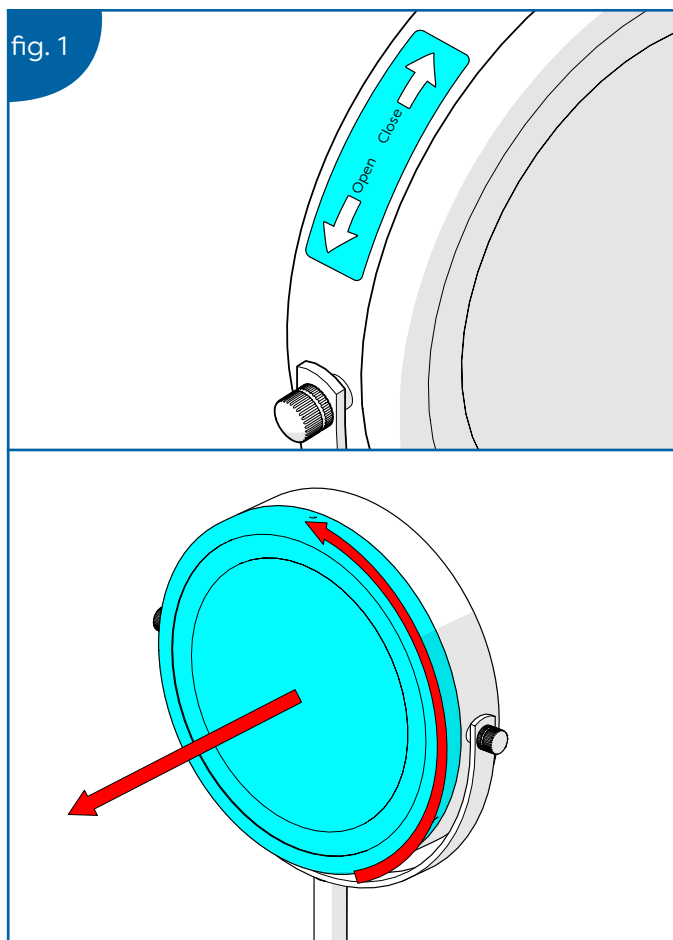
- 1. DO NOT** use abrasive or chemical cleaners as these may damage the product.

- 4. DO NOT** break open or burn used batteries. Incorrect disposal of spent batteries may be hazardous to health.



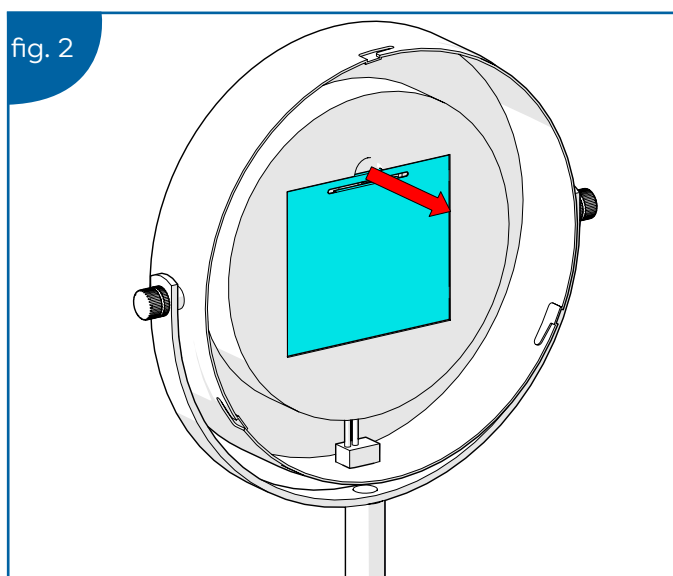
SECTION 3 - PRODUCT ASSEMBLY

INSTALLING BATTERIES

1. Rotate the front cover in the open direction according to the sticker on the product. Then remove the front cover. (See Fig. 1)



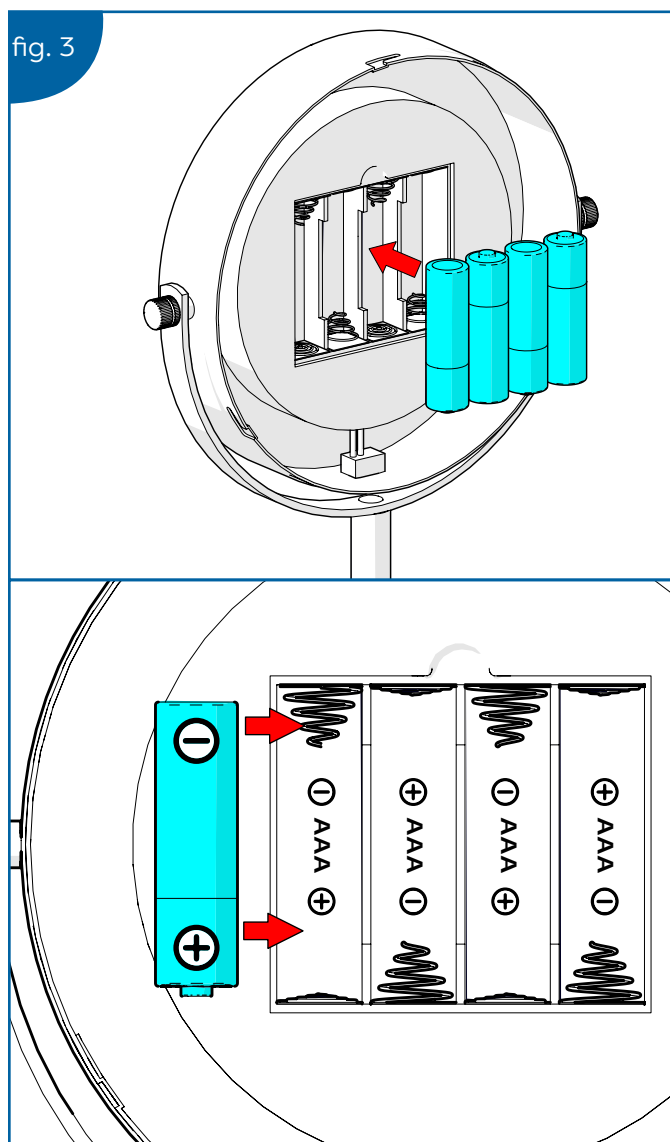
2. Remove the battery cover. (See Fig. 2)



3. Insert 4 AAA batteries into the battery compartment.

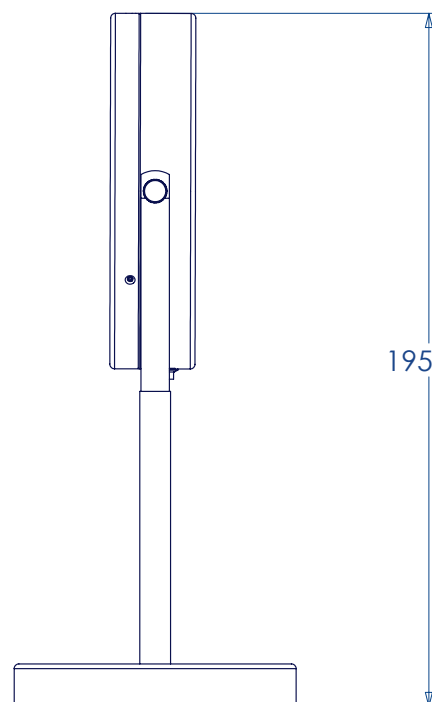
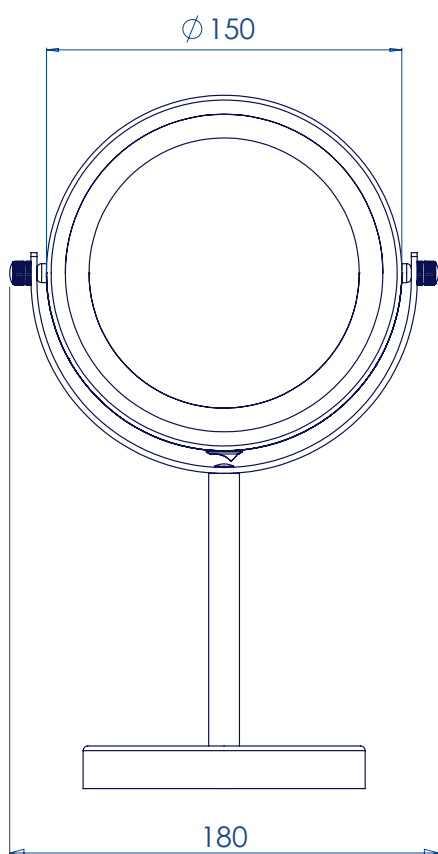
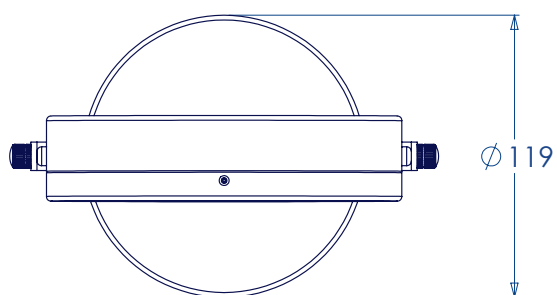


4. Reinstall the battery cover and the front cover.
