



- **2. ALWAYS** clean the product regularly with a soft damp cloth to retain the best quality finish.




INSTALLATION


Check all components are in the 1. packaging. (See Fig. 1a and 1b)




2. into each of the fixing holes in part C. (See Fig. 2) Note: Ensure the grub screw heads on the brackets are facing the opposite side to the toilet roll holder.

Insert one bracket






Slot the glass panel into both brackets. Ensure the glass panel is butted up to the bottom guide. Secure together by tightening the grub screws using a cross head screw driver. (See Fig. 3) DO NOT **OVERTIGHTEN.**




Insert one bracket 4. into each of the fixing holes in part D. (See Fig. 4)




Slot the glass panel into both brackets. Ensure the glass panel is butted up to the bottom guide. Secure together by tightening the grub screw on the two brackets using the cross head screw driver.

(See Fig. 5) Note: Ensure the grub screw head on the brackets are facing the opposite side to the toilet roll holder. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.




Line up the fixing holes on part C and D with the two wider sets of holes in the base plate, ensuring the toilet roll holder on part C is orientated correctly. Insert 2x counter sunk screw (A) then tighten with the 4mm Hex Key to secure in place. (See fig.6) Note: Ensure that the rubber feet are facing downwards. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.




Line up the spare toilet roll holder fixing hole with the hole located in the base plate and insert 1x counter sunk screw (A) then tighten with the 4mm Hex Key to secure in place.

(See fig.7) Note: Ensure both toilet roll holders are on the same side.


DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.




Line up the fixing hole on the brush holder with the remaining hole on the base plate. Insert 1x long counter sunk screw (B) then tighten with the 4mm Hex Key to secure in place. (See fig.8) DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.




9. Slot the toilet brush into the toilet brush holder. *(See fig.9)*



Line up the fixing holes on the shelf with the fixing holes on part C and D, ensuring the rim of the shelf is facing upwards. Insert 2x counter sunk screw (A) then tighten with the 4mm Hex Key to secure in place. (See fig.8) DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.



Clean the top surface of the shelf ensuring it is completely dry and free of any dust or debris. Peel the protective backing off the non-slip pad. Ensure the adhesive pad is facing downwards then line it up with the shelf. Apply even pressure and ensure the adhesive pad has made full contact with the top surface of the shelf. (See fig.11)
