Product Care Instructions

Characteristics

Every ceramic sink is unique - this is due to the natural clay material used and the imprecise process of firing, therefore, it is impossible to avoid small imperfections, also minor tolerances in the dimensions stated should be expected.

Heat Resistance

Ceramic sinks are highly heat resistant and can withstand the residual heat from pots and pans taken directly from the oven or hob.

Caution

Avoid using plastic washing-up bowls, as particles of grit can become impregnated in the base of the bowl and act like sand-paper causing permanent scratching to the glazed surface.

Routine Cleaning

As the surface is extremely smooth and non-porous, cleaning with soapy water is usually all that is required to keep your sink clean. More stubborn stains can be removed using our Clearwater ceramic and Cast Iron cleaner. Available from your sink retailer or direct from the contact details below. Always wipe down with a dry towel or microfibre cloth after use, this will help to avoid any lime scale build-up or staining.

Stains

If stains become particularly difficult to remove, an over-night soak using biological washing powder should help remove any marks.

Bleach & Acids

The ceramic surface will not be affected by bleach or acids found in the kitchen, however, it is advisable to use only diluted bleach in or on the sink, this is because the chrome wastes and taps can be damaged by extended exposure to neat bleach.

Limescale

In hard water areas limescale can build-up on the surface and become visible when stained by food and drink. We recommend regular cleaning with a solution of 3-parts hot water and 1-part white vinegar or specific limescale cleaners can be used for example Viakal.

Metal Marks

Pans and cutlery can leave grey metal marks on the surface as the finish is much harder than the metal utensils used in the kitchen. These marks can be easily removed using our Clearwater ceramic and cast iron cleaner - available from your sink retailer.

Lifetime Warranty

We guarantee to replace or repair any Ceramic sink due to manufacturing defects within its lifetime from the date of purchase. The warranty does not cover normal wear and tear, accidental damaged, scuff, scrapes or dents, improper installation or care.

The owner must follow and use the care and cleaning instructions provided. Accessories and waste fittings are not included in this warranty.

Proof of purchase must be provided.
